What's School Like for K-12 Students Who Express a Transgender Identity or Gender Nonconformity?

78% are harassed

35% are physically assaulted

12% are sexually assaulted

6% are expelled

A 2009 report from the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network paints a grim picture. Nearly 90 percent of transgender youth surveyed had experienced verbal harassment at school because of their gender expression. Two-thirds expressed feeling unsafe at school; more than half experienced physical harassment. A quarter experienced physical assault. Most of these incidents were never reported to school officials."-Carry Kilman,


