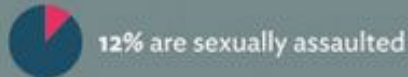
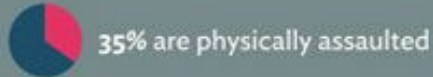
Gender and Identity

“Compared to the general population, gender-diverse kids face drastically increased rates of **bullying, assault, depression, school drop-out, drug abuse, self-harm and suicide**. A 2009 report from the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network paints a grim picture. Nearly 90 percent of transgender youth surveyed had experienced **verbal harassment** at school because of their gender expression. Two-thirds expressed feeling **unsafe** at school; more than half experienced **physical harassment**. A quarter experienced **physical assault**. Most of these incidents were never reported to school officials.”-Carry Kilman,

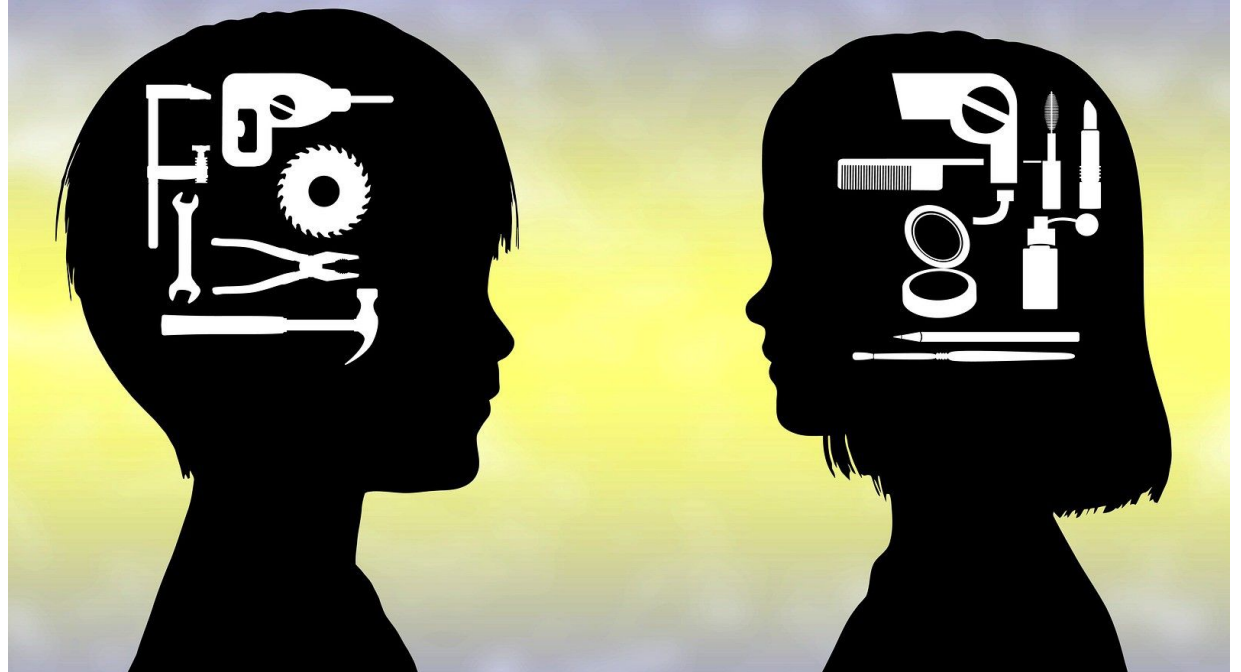

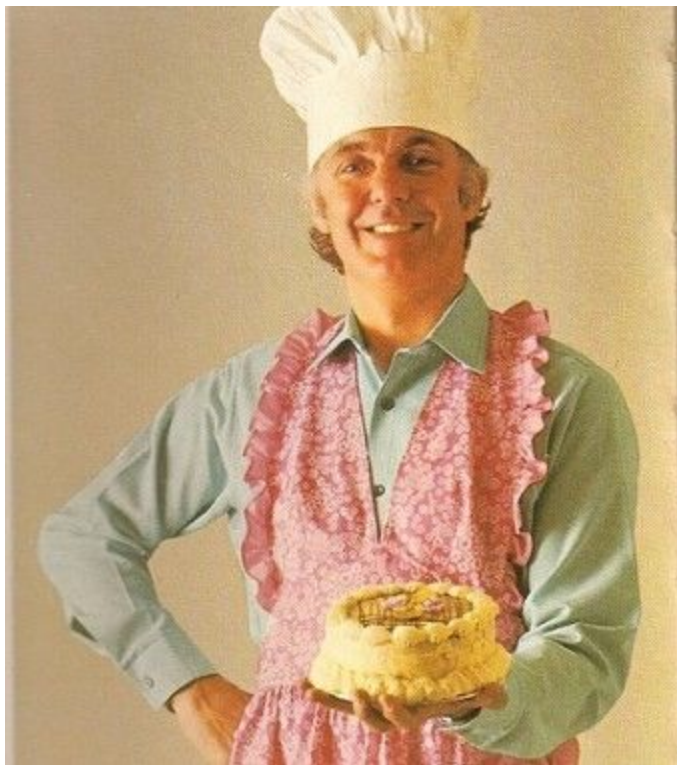
